- (11) Inconsiderate → Fears
- (12) Inconsiderate → Harms

Selfish (Resentments)

I am resentful at the City Of Minneapolis, Bill B. and Dave A. The cause of the resentment is I had to fight to get a promotion that I felt I was clearly deserving of because of my seniority and qualifications. It didn't matter who I harmed along the way. What did seem to matter to me was the money, less work, more power and me getting my way!

Because of my selfishness, my self esteem was affected because I wasn't willing to understand why they had a problem seeing that I was the best for the job.

Because of my selfishness, my personal relationships were affected because I felt forced to step on some toes to get what I wanted.

Because of my selfishness, my material security was affected because 1 thought I may have advanced faster or further had these things happened sooner or on my terms.

Because of my selfishness, my emotions are effic cted because of the bad feelings I feel for these people.

Because of my selfishness, my social ambitions may have been harmed because I can't or don't trust myself at any social events where I know they will be for fear of what I may say or do.

<u>Because of my selfishness</u>, my future security was affected due to the loss of money which <u>I felt</u> may hamper my ambitions. My retirement fund and my wages are mainly what I thought may have been effected.

No matter what their part in this was, I took <u>selfishness</u> to an extreme. It was an obsession that helped create the resentment and emotions. Had I been less selfish, I may have been able to handle the situation differently with the same or better results. I would have been able to let go and move on!

Selfish

(Fear)

I am fearful of bankruptcy. The cause of this fear is my staying home with the girls and my husband not making enough money.

<u>Because of my selfishness</u>, my self esteem is affected because <u>I think</u> I can't buy and do the things <u>I'd like</u> to do for my family, <u>I feel</u> less than.

Because of my selfishness, my personal relationships are affected because all I talk about is my lack of money so therefore I feel unable to do a lot with my friends.

<u>Because of my selfishness</u>, my material security is affected because all I look at is what <u>I</u> think I can't do or can't have because of no money.

<u>Because of my selfishness</u>, my security ambition is affected because <u>I don't feel</u> financially stable.

Because of my <u>selfishness</u>, no matter how much money my husband made, it wouldn't be enough. I wanted more. I lost sight of faith in God that he would provide what was needed.

Selfish (Harms)

I harmed an old boyfriend, Rob. I feel that I harmed him because I stayed in the relationship for a year after I lost interest in him. I had put a lot of the money I had earned into the relationship. He kept assuring me that it wouldn't be long before he could pay me back and give me more than I could have on my own. I felt justified in staying with him, waiting for what I felt I had coming. My plan was to leave once I was paid back.

Because of my selfishness, my self esteem was affected because I felt I was better than Rob. I felt I had put more into the relationship than he had. I felt I was too good for him.

Because I my selfishness, my personal relationships were affected because I gossiped to my friends and family about what a "loser" he was. They, in tum, tried to talk me into leaving, which I had no intention of doing until I was paid back. This caused tension in my relationships with my family.

<u>Because of my selfishness</u>, my material security instinct was threatened because <u>I</u> thought if I left, when emotionally the relationship was over, I wouldn't get my money and I would start over with nothing.

Because of my selfishness, my emotional security instinct was threatened because I was depending on him to pay me back. I wasn't working toward any arrangements for him to pay me back. I thought I needed to keep him emotionally locked into the relationship in order to get my money. We took turns emotionally dominating the relationship.

Because of my selfishness, my acceptable sex relations were affected because I had

trouble having any sex relations with him once my feelings for him had changed.

Because of my selfishness, my hidden sex relations were affected because once my feelings for him had changed, I began to find that I was interested in other men. I flirted wift them and lead them on. I wanted to know that once I was single again, I could find

men who would be interested in me.

Because of my selfishness, my security ambitions were affected because I wanted to make sure I got the money I needed to get an apartment and other things I wanted to get started in my life without him.

Because of my selfishness my sexual ambitions were affected because I had to put them on hold until I got my money. I had no sexual ambitions with Rob.

I took <u>selfishness</u> to an extreme, Rob's part could have changed if I hadn't been <u>selfish</u>. I didn't have to give him the money in the first place. My <u>selfishness</u> got in the way because I believed I would get more later if I paid then. Had I been less <u>selfish</u>, I would have kept the financial situation separate from the emotional situation. Instead I used his feelings for me and was dishonest about my feelings for him to ensure payment.
